

The number of submissions is limited to 2 per submitting author.

Abstracts can be submitted for individual *paper presentation*, *symposium*, *workshop* or *poster presentation*.

**Individual paper presentation** aims at reporting on ongoing or completed studies in a 15 minutes oral presentation. Papers will be arranged in thematic sessions and assigned a specific slot by the Organizing Committee. Paper sessions last 60 minutes and consist of three presentations, with 15 minutes for discussion. Required information for the abstract submission: relevant conference theme, paper title, abstract (250-350 words), keywords (max 5), names of presenting author and co-authors and their institutions/organizations.

**Symposium** provides an opportunity for group discussion among colleagues on a specific topic. Please note that the chairperson of a Symposium is responsible for organizing all aspects of the Symposium, including the participation of the presenters and the discussant(s). Symposium lasts max 90 minutes. Required information for the abstract submission: relevant conference theme; for the symposium you need to provide: symposium title, abstract (250-350 words), keywords (max: 4), name(s) of the discussant(s) (max 2) and their institution/organization; for each presentation in the symposium you need to provide: paper title, abstract (250-350 words), keywords (max 5), names of the presenting author and co-authors and their institutions/organizations.

**Workshop** is an opportunity to present practical approaches, discuss specific case studies or introduce novel techniques. The main focus is the development of skills and participants' experiential involvement. A detailed description of the approach, case study or a technique that will be addressed in the workshop should be described in the submission, including theoretical background, aims, step-by-step procedures and other relevant aspects. Workshops last 45 or 90 minutes. Required information for the abstract submission: relevant conference theme, workshop title, abstract (250-350 words), keywords (max 5), names of presenting and co-authors and their institutions/organizations.

**Posters** are suitable for a variety of contributions, including completed projects, theoretical contributions, single case studies, pilot studies, and work-in-progress. Poster dimensions should approximate 80 x 100 cm (32 x 40 inches). When possible the Posters will be grouped by the topic to stimulate discussion and exchange of ideas. Required information for the abstract submission: relevant conference theme; poster title, abstract (250-350 words), keywords (max: 4), names of presenting and co-authors and their institutions/organizations. In case of a virtual conference, posters will be still presented.
